**As an update to what has been taking place, we have secured our very own CCLI license! That means that we are completely legal in making sure that the songs that we sing (and are copyrighted) are covered! What I have done (and we must keep doing) is that we keep track of songs that we sing at gatherings, team meetings, walks and any other Emmaus event, and every so often we are required to report that usage so that the authors and artists get paid their royalties. It is the Music Director's responsibility on every walk to keep track of what songs are used and report them to the Music board rep at the end of that walk. I want to "Thank" those that have already cooperated with this and would encourage you all to help keep this up! Also with this new procedure, we can no longer allow any songbooks or lead sheets, lyrics, etc. to be taken home from the walks. You all have been doing such a good job of cooperating with this so far, and I sure appreciate that!**

**Next, I am in the process of updating the songbooks for the community as well. I am going to have new songbooks printed for the conference room as well as a Master Music Director's book complete with words, chords, etc. If you have any song suggestions that you would like to see added, please let me know ASAP!**
